The Federal Crop Insurance Company (FCIC) has completed its review and evaluation of Corporación de Seguros Agrícolas de Puerto Rico's (CSA) Plan of Operation (Plan) for the 2012 reinsurance year (4/1/2012 to 3/31/2013) submitted with your letter of February 2, 2012.

CSA has requested approval to write up to a maximum premium amount of \$6,000,000.
